We were very happy to receive your letter reporting reception of our special dx broadcast of October 27 from 2:00 A.M. CST until 3:30.

Your report has been checked with our test log and has been found to be correct. Therefore, we are pleased to verify your reception of KAWL at your location.

Reports were received from 45 dxers in the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Iowa, Maryland, Massachusetts, Nebraska, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Washington, and 2 reports from Ontario.

This station is owned and operated by the Prairie States Broadcasting Company, soon to be in operation as of a new radio station, KRSL, in Russell, Kansas on 990 kilocycles.

York is a city of approximately 6400 people and is located at the center of one of the Midwest's richest agricultural areas, pioneering in irrigation. The city has been given the name, "The Nation's Egg Center".

KAWL is located at the south edge of town on Highway 81. If you ever have the opportunity to visit our area, drop by. Our antenna is 200 feet high and most of our equipment is Gates.
