This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of September 6th for which we sincerely thank you.

We have checked your report of reception and find it is essentially correct, and hope that you will be able to tune us in again during the remainder of daylight saving.

You may be interested in knowing that WSNJ operates daily from 7:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. and on Sundays from 9:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M., EDST. The transmitter is a RCA 100E standard 100 watt installation, using four type 203a tubes in the final amplifier. The antenna is a grounded $\frac{1}{4}$ wave vertical tower, 180 feet high with feed line tapped $\frac{1}{3}$ way up.

We would be pleased to hear from you again should you pick us up, and we will be glad to receive any comments you have to make.
