Dear Mr. Brauner:

Yours of December 24th at hand, and in reply I would say that you are correct in assuming that you picked up station WEAJ at Cornell University, Ithaca, New York, during the noon hour of the 24th. The items which you described accord with our program for that day.

We are endeavoring at the present time to get double the power which we have, and in that case, I expect that you would be able to get our station effectively. It is quite remarkable that you picked us up at all, as we are only using the amount allotted to us by the Federal Radio Commission, which is 500 watts.

We need the help of all the affidavits that we can have from people around the state to the effect that our program will be of value and that they are not able to get it effectively with our present power and frequency. I am sorry not to be able to send you an Ekko stamp, as we do not have any at the present time, and am therefore returning your remittance of ten cents (\$.10). I am also enclosing our program for the months of January, February and March.
