Dear Mr. Brauner:

Thank you very much for your letter telling of your hearing WLCI, Ithaca, New York in a test program for the Radio Commission on January 6th, between 3 and 3:30 A.M. This letter is a verification of your reception of WLCI.

We were on the air at that time. All that our radio operator did for that half hour was to call signals every three minutes as the inspector at Detroit was listening in to see how near we were to our frequency of 1210 Kilocycles. Many of our letters indicate that the writer heard also during that time many phonograph records. There were no phonograph records played by WLCI, nothing but the calling of signals, so that it is certain that these came from some other broadcasting station which was on the air at the same time and probably with the same frequency.

We shall be very happy to have you send in a card anytime that you may happen to hear our station and we thank you for your letter.

Enclosed is an Ekko stamp, for which we have received your dime.
