MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE EACH THURSDAY MORNING
AFTER 1:00 AM BUT SOME TIMES WE DON'T HAVE
THE AM TRANSMITTER ON. WE WILL DEFINATELY
BE ON AUGUST 17 AFTER ONE O'CLOCK.

THE TRANSMITTER IS A NEW GATES BC-1-F,
FEEDING A 342' SHUNT EXCITED TOWER WHICH
ALSO SUPPORTS OUR GE 4 BAY FM ANTENNA. WE
ARE LOCATED ABOUT FIVE MELES EAST OF THE
CITY OF OSWEGO, OVERLOOKING LAKE ONTARIO.
