Dear Mr. Brauner;

Thank you for your report of reception of WPUT during our recent test broadcast. We are pleased to verify your reception of WPUT, 1510 kHz, on Monday morning February 10, 1975 at both our regular daytime power of 895 watts and our special pre-sunrise power of 50 watts. The latter power has been authorized by the Federal Communications Commission for a maximum of one hour's use prior to sunrise, due to the enactment of daylight time during those months when standard time normally is observed. We were on the air testing from 2:00am until 3:01am E.S.T. on February 10. We have a single tower, 140 feet high, located right outside our studio and office building, about 3/4 mile north of the downtown area of the village of Brewster, New York. We heard from a total of 72 DXers as a result of the test broadcast, the most distant being in Lincoln, Nebraska (Carl Dabelstein). A very successful test!

It was good hearing from you; sorry for the delay in answering.
