Hi Joe:

Glad to hear from you, and sorry that I was unable to answer your letters sooner. We have been very busy here at WCIN. I am now employed here as an engineer. In fact, I've been here since last June, as I helped build the station.

This letter will verify that you were listening to WCIN on October 12, 1953 at 2:30 AM EST, and December 20, 1953 from 7:30 to 8:00 AM EST. The first time you heard us we were making final adjustments to the transmitting equipment prior to our opening on October 26, 1953. I am rather surprised that you were able to hear us on our regular schedule. What happened to WLEA?

WCIN operates on 1480 kcs with 1,000 watts directional antenna, from 6:00 AM EST to local sunset, which is now 6:15 PM. WCIN is entirely negro-programmed.

I am enclosing your verification card, and am sorry that I had to trouble you with the card and a second letter, but glad you heard us on RS.
