We were on with a test program being run in connection with certain new equipment and might add that your comment as to announcements not being so good is correct inasmuch as we were using a single button microphone at the transmitter site proper as we had no other regular microphone on hand at that point for the test. The recordings were also played from that point with a pick-up unit which was not the best either. Of course our regular studio equipment is the best obtainable and the quality much better than that to which you listened.

During the tests both 100 and 250 watts power were used and we are glad to have your confirmation of reception at Buffalo.
