Dear Mr. Brauner:-

The writer is in receipt of your report on our frequency check program heard from 2:00 A.M. to 4:00 A.M. E.S.T. on the morning of June 20th and wishes to thank you therefor.

To say the least your report is very gratifying when the conditions of weather and interference are taken into consideration.

For your information will say that the government test on this program placed our frequency at 1369.759 KC on observations covering a period of one hour. This may assist you in calibrating your receiver.

From reports received extending from the east coast to the west coast and from San Antonio, Texas, to Winnipeg, Canada, it would seem that our little transmitter is about as closely adjusted as it is possible to get it. However, we shall be very glad at any time to have criticisms or suggestions from any member of the "Old Timers Club" as we have previously found its reports dependable and sufficiently detailed to be of considerable value to us.
