Dear Mr. Brauner:

We wish to thank you for your fine letter of December 9th, informing us of your reception of our station at 6:20 AM of December 9th. As our station is new on the air, we are much interested in its coverage, quality, etc., as regards our listening audience.

Our transmitting equipment consists of an RCA one kilowatt AM unit and a Westinghouse three kilowatt FM unit. The AM antenna is a four tower directional array bearing north. The FM antenna is a four section RCA pylon. Our operation daytime on AM is non-directional using one tower only of the array. We operate directional at night. Our present broadcast day begins at 6:00AM and ends at 1:30AM.
