Station W8X0 is an experimental station which is licensed to operate only between the hours of 12 Midnight and 6:00 A.M., Eastern Standard Time.

In addition to various special unscheduled experimental transmissions, at the present time station W8X0 is regularly scheduled to operate daily from 12 Midnight to 2:00 A.M. Eastern Standard Time, during which period the regular programs of station WLW are broadcast.
