Dear Mr. Brauner:

This is to confirm your report of reception of our signals on October 23, 1949, at 6:00 A.M.

Our transmitter is an R.C.A. BTA-250-L feeding directly into a Tylon 150 ft. guyed tower. The ground system consists of 120 radials, 200 feet long. The transmitter is located approximately one mile west of East Liverpool on what is said to be the highest point visible from the Ohio River at any place.

Our studios are located on the "Diamond" in downtown East Liverpool- equipment there is also R.C.A.

Our testing schedule is indefinite due to WWSW's occupancy of this frequency. However, we expect to be on again on the morning of October 30th.
