Thank you very much for your report of reception of WSRW. This will verify that you heard us at 1:46 AM EST on December 20, 1960. At that time, we had just finished tuning our antenna, and were testing the equipment. We were operating with 500 watts, non-directional on 1590 kilocycles

I remember that mornign very well, as we worked outside, up on a platform, for several hours, and it was extremely cold.

For your information, we operate from local sunrise to local sunset, serving the Southern Ohio rural area. Our tower is 185' high, and the station is equiped with Gates throughout.
