Dear Mr. Brauner

In reply to your letter of Oct. 11, 1959. We are pleased to tell you that you did hear WTIG on the morning of Oct. 10th. at 7:30 AM, EDST.

The sign on that you heard was WTIG's, The announcer gives the station call, location, date, number of the day in the year, days remaining in the year and the outstanding historical events which have happened on this date.

WTIG is located 40° 49' 56.1" Latitude, and 81° 33' 39.7" Longitude. The Studios are located in downtown Massillon and the Transmitter is located apx. 3.2 miles N.W. of town. We operate at a frequency of 990kc. at a power of 250 Watt. The Transmitter is a Collins Make, Model 300-J. Three 200 Ft. Guyed towers make up the transmitting antenna array, which are on a true North South Axis. The pattern is of a cardioid type South.

THE overall height above mean sea level is 1303'
We are a Daylight station operating from local Sunrise to Sunset.

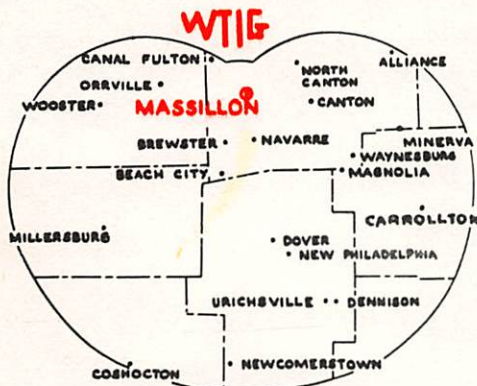
It might also be of interesting to note that Massillon is located apx. 125 miles from Valier.
