

Dear DX Friend:


Received your letter of report of the test of October 13. Sure do thank you lots for your wonderful cooperation and information.

Surely the pest could go off the air for just 20 minutes per month and give our poor little 100 watts of ~~power~~ power a small chance at being picked up.

Again may I thank you and the Newark News Radio Club for your very kind and helpful Cooperation and invite you and all the other members to be listening in for the test next month. It will be on the second Tuesday of November (Nov. 10 if I am not mistaken) from 2:20 to 2:40 am. est. (3:20-3:40am. EST)
