Thanks for your letter of 9 May '48.....and sorry about not answering sooner. But the truth of the matter is we've been so busy getting this monster on the air that I've just now had time to answer....and the Chief Engineer is still unsettled.


We went on the air at 6:26:30 AM CST, 14 May 1948. Since that time we've had many letters similar to yours. On the morning of 9 May between 2:15-2:30 AM we were having a frequency measurement done by Standard Measurements at Enid, Oklahoma. We were zeroed in and since that time have had three other checks made.

Yes, your report was correct in all respects....except the "3:15 and 3:30 AM ~~CSB~~" time was concerned. Had you taken into consideration Eastern Daylight Saving Time?

We are 500-watts, anMBS affiliate, Collins equipment all new with the exception of the Frequency Monitor and Modulation Monitor - both General Radio. Transmitter is a Collins 20-T. We hope to go 1000 Watts by this fall and are toying with fulltime FM now. We are fortunate in sounding considerably better than adjacent stations of the 250-Watt class.

Again thank you for your report and please drop in at your first opportunity.
