I find your description of your receiving facilities interesting as well as your detailed description of the conditions on 950 in your area.

All of our frequency checks are made by The Pennsylvania State College Electrical Engineering Department during operating hours. Unfortunately, all test's here are made as needed and as convenient to the chief engineer. Since we have no regular test period or date I can't help you out there. Perhaps you'll just run across us some night.
