We wish to thank you kindly for report on reception of our station; nomely RADIO TUPI PRG-3 on february 12th.

For your information, our transmitter is a 50 KW RCA model BTA-50F. The transmitter station is situated on reclaimed marshland about 20 Kilometers north of the city, about 1 kilometer Iland from Guanabara Bay. The entire area of Rio de Janeiro and its suburbs is surrounded by mountains some of which reach the height of 2500 feet.


Our short wave Channel is on 15.370 Kcs. with a power of 1 KW.
