Dear Mr. Brauser;


Your letter of January 13th. was sincerely appreciated.

With respect to your suggestion, I regret that I cannot give you a definite promise as to whether I can conduct a test at the time you have mentioned. However, my regular test schedule is as follows: 2nd. & 4th. Fridays of each month, at 3:30-3:45 AM CST. We operate from 6 AM until 12 MN all week days except Saturdays, on which day, we operate until 2 AM Sunday morning. All times are CST.

Should you hear me on one of my test runs, I should be glad to hear from you. Also, I will try to arrange to furnish a test for you sometime in the near future, if I am unable to work on the date you suggested. An indefinite answer is necessitated by the fact that we are expecting to go to 1 KW in the near future, so you can see that at a time like this, Engineer's are in the "sweating" status so to speak. I'm sure you have been through some of this in your experience.
