Dear Mr. Brauner:

Your letter arrived today, and allow me to take this opportunity to thank you very much. It was very interesting to know that our signals were reaching out as far as Williamsville with such quality when only 250 watts were on the antenna. Our frequency has some bearing however, but I noticed you have a very sensitive receiver. We are only a daytime outlet, with a primary service area of 40 miles radius covering all of Box Elder County, Utah.

We are pleased to report that our log checks exactly with the information you sent, and our closing statements as we left the air coincide with the remarks of your letter. Our present schedule calls for a weekly frequency check on Monday mornings at 1:00 a.m. Mountain Standard Time.

I am very appreciative of your favor to us, and I hope this return will give ample verification of your reception with our station.
