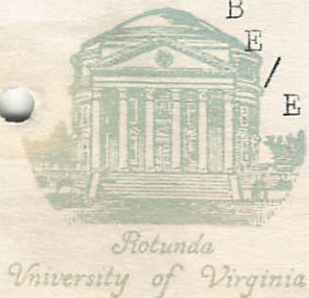
Thank you very much for your letter, and we sincerely hope that you will be a regular "early-morning" listener of ours.
