We ran test broadcasts from Monday May 26 through Saturday May 31 from 5:30 A.M. E.D.T. until 6:00 A.M. E.D.T. The object of the test was to determine the amount of interference between WEAM and other stations on 1390. We're trying to get permission to sign on at 6:00 A.M. permanently. We've had no results so far from the test.

We have 1000 Raytheon watts with a shunt-fed, 230', self-supporting, Blaw-Knox tower.
