Dear Mr. Brauner

Although you did not request verification of our recent test broadcast of November 15, 1949, I do wish to thank you very much for reporting the reception conditions in your area. I enjoyed reading your letter very much and am very glad to hear from you again.

We found that in general conditions were not favorable for good DX on Nov 15th. We did not receive too many reports and in most cases they showed a weak signal report. Your comments on KOFO were most interesting also. We did encounter some QRM in certain areas but no one gave as many details as you.

In case you wish to consider this letter another verification you may do so for you have given sufficient proof in your letter that you were listening to us on the morning of Nov. 15, 1949.

As you know, we are testing again on Dec 15, Jan 15, and Feb 15th from 0400-0530 EST. I hope many of the DXers get a chance to tune us in and send us a report. I certainly appreciate reports such as yours. Many of the DXers report just once and after receiving a verification never again write.

We have been consulting the chief engineer of WQQW for a test broadcast but thus far without much luck. Harold Schrock, who reads our DX news on our test programs, has offered to write their verification letters if they would put on a test. We both will continue and try to get them to test sometime.

Again many thanks for writing and showing us such interest.
