Thanks for your letter reporting reception of WINC. It is apparent from information contained in your letter that you heard WINC, even though conditions were far from favorable.

This letter may be considered a verification of your reception of WINC, Winchester.

WINC uses only 250 watts on 1400 kilocycles, and is located on the outskirts of Winchester, a town of about 13000, yet rather consistently receives favorable reports from points as far north as Canada.

I am sorry you had so much difficulty receiving verification of reception of this station. Usually mail addressed directly to me at WFVA will receive prompt attention. I'm afraid I never received your letter addressed to WINC for some unknown reason.
