Dear Mr. Brauner:

Thank you for your letter and your report of reception of WPID, October 24, 1940 at 5.30 am to 6.00 am. We have checked it with our station log and are pleased to find it correct. This is your verification.

Our studios are located in downtown Petersburg, (31,000 1940 census) and transmitter approximately one mile from our studios in Colonial Heights, Virginia.

WPID employs RCA high-fidelity equipment both in the studios and at the transmitter, and uses a 196 foot Lingo flagpole vertical radiator.

We operate daily weekdays from 7 am to 11.00 p.m., and on Sundays from 1.30 pm to 5.30 pm, sharing Sundays only with WBBL of the Grace Covenant Presbyterian Church in Richmond, Virginia.

WPID began operation June 5, 1940, with 250 watts power day and night, and is owned and operated by the Petersburg Newspaper Corporation.

Thank you for your interest in our station, and we trust that in the future you will hear many more of WPID's broadcasts.
