Dear Sir:-

Many thanks for your report of reception of station K-I-R-O. This is your verification that on November 5th, 1935; from 1:27AM to 2:02AM Pacific Standard Time; you heard station K-I-R-O, Seattle, Washington, operating on a frequency of 710 kilocycles and a power of 500 watts. In your letter you mentioned fine tonal quality and modulation. Station K-I-R-O is the first high-fidelity station in the Pacific Northwest - frequency curve being flat from 30 to 14,000 cycles with a loss of 2 DB to 16,000 cycles.
