Dear Mr. Brauner:


Thank you for your fine report of our program for the National Radio Club, 5:00 to 6:00 A.M. to CWT Sunday January 30, 1944. Your report was checked and was found to be correct. We do not have any SWL Cards at the present time, so I am therefore sending this letter as a verification of same.

At the time you heard us we were operating under our War time power which necessitates a one decibel reduction which brings our power down to approximately 200 watts.

At the present time we are on the air the first Wednesday Morning of each month, from 1:00 to 1:45 A.M. CWT, for a frequency check with the Phelps Laboratory of Minneapolis, Minnesota.

On behalf of the management of the station I wish to thank you again for your fine report.
