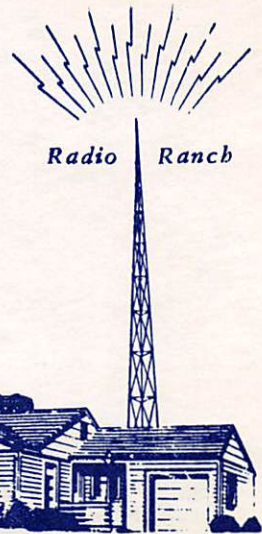

This is to acknowledge the letter you sent on the 17th of November in which you indicated the reception of WTKM. Needless to say, we of the engineering department, were happy to hear from you and we thank you very much.

We can verify the report you gave us since the information you presented was accurate enough to merit comment. We enjoy hearing from those who take time out and write to us.

WTKM is an independent station and it classified as Regional - Class ^N 2I. As you already know, the power here is 500 watts. We use two Eimac type 250TL tubes as the push-pull power amplifier. The Modulator stage uses two Eimac type 250 TH tubes. The antenna is a self-supported Blaw-Knox which rises 320 feet into the upper stratosphere.

We do not have a specific test schedule but we usually make periodic tests around the fifteenth of each month.
