This is to confirm your reception report of January 13th and January 16th.


We are both surprised and pleased that you were able to copy this station. We can understand however, why we might have some QRM with a couple of 50 kw's for competition.

In the line of programming, we have a varied program schedule that includes Pop, Country and Rock 'n Roll in that order of precedence. As you mentioned we try to promote our news very heavily. We have utilized the novelty of the space age (who has it) by recording a news opening and closing using various sound effects of rockets, missiles and jets.
