
Thank you for your report of August 19, 1946 on hearing our station. A check of our log shows you to be correct at the time and date stated in your report. Our test schedule is now 3:45 AM to 4:00 AM EST each morning and our regular program schedule is from 6:00 AM to Midnight each day. If you should hear us during our regular program schedule I would appreciate a report on the reception.

I am an old amateur operator having operated W9OAJ in Wichita, Kansas for some years. I formerly worked at KFBI in Wichita, Kansas. Chief Engineer at KTSW and the police radio KQUJ in Emporia, Kansas. And operator at WSPA in Spartanburg, So Car. I have been with this station since the time construction was started.
