Gentlemen:

It was my pleasure to be able to monitor KGEE on 9 November 1970 at various moments between 12:00am and 1:04am Pacific Standard Time on 1230 Kcs,

I use a National NC-183D 17 tube communications receiver. My antenna is a 36" box loop pointed NE/SW. Your signal strength varied from nothing to fair due to fading. However, readability was about 5% due to the fading and interference from KWTC, KLAV, and testing by KELY & KGFJ, and others.

The below log, in PST, is offered as proof of reception:

- 12:00am: First heard: "Stay tuned for more music after tonight. This is Station KGEE, Bakersfield, California. KGEE is owned and operated by KGN Corporation located at 207 Broxton Avenue and transmitter at the corner of and Bell Terrace. KGEE operated on an assigned frequency of 12-30 kilocycles with a daytime power of 1 000 watts and 250 watts nighttime power as authorized by the Federal Communications Commission in Washington, DC. We invite you now...." Music.
- 12:02: Music with the Mills Bros. KGEE??
- 12:10: Recorded ad for Mayfair Markets. Not sure this was KGEE.
- 12:23: Live ad for Tiny's Restaurant -- take the California Avenue off-ramp of Rte. 99 to 18th and
- 12:59: Talk under KWTC. "This is KGEE...Radio...California...Monday thru Sunday...." "News on the hour. Here's JIM...."
- 1:02: Report by Peter Bruns, NBC News, Saigon. Soon KLAV dominates freq.

If my report has proved to your satisfaction that I did hear KGEE, I would like to receive a QSL card or letter of verification. It is important to me that your reply contain the time and date of the confirmed broadcast and is signed by a station official. For your convenience in replying I have enclosed return postage. I would also be interested in obtaining a copy of your horizontal radiation pattern similar to that submitted to the FCC, if possible. Thank you.
