Your report of Sept. 25, 1969 from 11:29 AM to 12:19 PM was received, checked with the station log and found to be correct.

Radio KLOK is located approximately 5 miles southeast of downtown San Jose and operates on 10 kilowatts day and 5 kilowatts night. Our antenna system is comprised of three 200-foot towers in a straight line 71 degrees east of north. All three are used at night and the center and westerly tower are used during the day.

The transmitter currently in use day and night is an RCA BT-5/10 U which was put in service in May of 1967. The older RCA BT-10F is used as an auxiliary transmitter.

Thank you for listening and I'm happy to verify your report at this time.
