Radio Station KWKW's beginnings go back to the Forties and in the Fifties became a Spanish Language Station. It operates with a 3 tower directional array both day and night with a power of 5000 watts daytime and 1000 watts nighttime. All programming, including the Los Angeles Dodgers baseball games are broadcast in Spanish.
