We are always happy to hear from our distant listeners and hope you enjoy the programming on KYOS.

A word about our equipment...mostly of RCA manufacture. The KYOS transmitter is a BTH-5F, located six miles north of the city of Merced, and is remotely controlled from our main studio in downtown Merced.

3-240 ft. towers bring our night time directional signal to a maximum strength in a southwesterly direction. KYOS operates non-directional in the daytime, and is 5000 watts both day and night.

KYOS begins broadcasting each day at 5:30 A.M. and 6:45 A.M. on Sundays. Sign off time is 12:00 midnight.

Again, we thank you for your report, and we welcome your future comments when atmospheric conditions permit you to receive KYOS.
