- 1:01: Talk - Time, one minute fifteen seconds after two, Central Standard Time. -- check that -- Central DAYLIGHT Time. Now one minute thirty seconds past one, Central STANDARD Time. News.
- 1:06: Weather - 52° at Lake Front.
- 1:07: Time, 7 past 1 CST - ad for American Airlines.
- 1:08: Theme music - talk (weak) Vienna Philhamonic mentioned. Music.
- 1:36: Talk -- Haydns' Clock Symphony. ID. Ad for American Airlines Cargo Service.
- 1:38: Time - weather, 30% chance of rain. Fade as more talk. Mentioned New York Philharmonic Orchestra. Music.
