

Dear Sir,

Thank you for your interesting letter of February 2nd which I am pleased to have the opportunity to reply. I would, however, point out that the BBC does not issue a verification in any form and this is a policy which has been decided after many years as it is very difficult for us to comply strictly in the terms of a QSL. You will appreciate that many hundreds of other organisations throughout the world rebroadcast BBC programmes and so many listeners are unable to give precise frequencies that in many cases a QSL card would not be sent. In the circumstances we have much pleasure in sending you one of our acknowledgement cards with this letter.

We are most interested in your various comments on Medium Wave reception. We confirm that the various remarks which you make concerning our transmission from Stagshaw are correct. This is a transmission intended for reception of the BBC's Home Service in the northern parts of England and operates on a frequency of 1151 kilocycles (260.6 metres).
