This will serve to verify your Reception Report dated 22nd November, 1962. We thank you for your interest.

We wish to inform you that we transmit on 10,000 Watts omni-directional daytime, and 5,000 Watts with a directional pattern night-time. This night-time pattern is rather heart shaped but with a minor lobe, on an axis running 10 degrees East of North. The major lobe, carrying about two thirds of the power is towards the North.

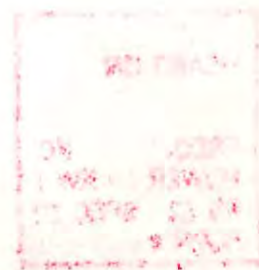
During the month of November we changed from night to daytime pattern at 7:15 am, and changed from day to night-time pattern at 6:45 p.m.

At the present time, we are sorry to say Radio Coverage Maps are not available.
