Thank you for your report of reception of Station WXYJ on December 10, 1962, from 4:19 to 4:33 AM. The report is an accurate description of the program transmitted at that time. It is good to know that you could hear WXYJ so well through all the QRM on 1340.

WXYJ operates from 5:30 AM to 1:05 AM weekdays, and from 7:55 AM to 12:05 AM on Sundays, with 250 watts non-directional. The antenna is a 150 foot self supported structure mounted on the roof of the WXYJ Building in downtown Jamestown. We are using a Western Electric 451A-1 transmitter.

Enclosed you will find a coverage map you requested. Once again, thanks for your report, and good luck in the future in your Radio Club activities. Seasons greetings.
