Dear Mr. Karchevski: Enclosed is one of our Tiger Track auto window stickers so you can see just what it is. As shown above is our operating powers. Formerly we were just Daytime only station operating with power of 1000 watts into two tower directional antenna. On June 21, 1963 we started program tests from our all new station from 106 Glenwood Ave., Cincinnati 17, Ohio on twenty four per day schedule with 5000 watts into two 420' and one 150' tower in triangular configuration Daytime and four 420' towers in line Nighttime. We start Night-time pattern at Local Average Sunset each month, however we are permitted to switch to Daytime Pattern at 0400 EST daily provided do not receive interference complaints from other stations on same frequency. At the time you were receiving us we would have been on Daytime power of 5000 Watts. Hope I have answered your questions. CJD
