Dear Mr. Karchevski:

Many thanks for your report on the reception of our station. I am sorry that it has taken me so long to answer your notice.

CFGM studios, located in Richmond Hill, Ontario, first broadcasted on the assigned frequency of 1300 kcs. On July 1st, 1957 with a limited broadcast schedule from sunrise to sunset and an omnidirection radiation pattern. On March 20th, 1959 we began broadcasting twenty-four hours a day with a power output of 1000 watts on a daytime pattern and 250 watts output on the night time pattern on the assigned frequency of 1310 kcs.

On October 13th, 1961 we were granted a further power increase to 10,000 watts daytime, 2500 watts night time and changed our call letters to CFGM from CJRH.

Our transmitter is located on the northern boundary of Metropolitan Toronto and our radiation pattern is of a cardioid nature with the main lobe beamed in a northwesterly direction. Our antennas consist of four towers in a rectangular shape with the two southerly towers being 90' out of phase with the northern towers. The antennas themselves are 179' high and the ground is approximately 600' above sea level.

At 6:05 the Bob Laine Show starts. It runs until 10:30 when the Dave Donaldson Show begins. Dave's show runs to 2:30 when the Jack Gracie show takes over. During these hours we have a newscast on the hour and news headlines on the half hour.

At 7:00 pm we start with a series of Language and Religious programs until midnight, with the exception of the weekend when we have your Weekend Bruce McInnes Show. At 12:00 we start our Night Riders Jamboree with "Uncle" Charley Babcock and six hours of Western Music.

We appreciate reports from listening posts such as yours and wish you continued success in the field of service. 73's and DX.
