Gentlemen:

I would like to report reception of KQIK during your equipment test of 6 April 1970, from 12:06am to 12:26am Pacific Standard Time. Your signal strength was weak and poor from 12:06 to 12:18. Then the strength increased noticeably. Your readability was about 0% for voice, 50% for code until 12:18. Afterwards, readability was about 60% for voice, 100% for code.

Below, in PST, are the announcements I heard:

12:05am: 1,000 cps tone loud - several other stations. KAAA(Arizona) ID in background.  
12:06: Approx: 600 cps tone on. Seems to be sending Morse Code.  
12:07: Code again. Tone off 30 seconds later.  
12:10 $\frac{1}{2}$ : Tone on (600 cps).  
12:11: Code: " K Q " (All I could hear).  
12:11 $\frac{1}{2}$ : More code, then a man's voice: "...KQIK in Lakeview, Oregon. 1230 on your dial...."  
12:16: Music: "I'll Never Fall In Love Again" Who??  
12:18: Music, country & western style (stops in middle -- then piano plays classical music). Quite loud.  
12:19: Pause -- more piano with lady singing. "I hear you calling"  
12:21 $\frac{1}{2}$ : A few words spoken (unreadable). Then code: A I K tone.  
12:22: More tone (600 cps) and code: Q I K K Q I K tone.  
12:23: All stations weak, KQIK fades out.  
12:25: Man says: "We have to kill the transmitter to make another check. Now this is KQIK in Lakeview, Oregon, 12-30 on your dial signing off for a few minutes. The next ... we will have a solid 10 or 15 minutes of tape as well as.... This is KQIK, Lakeview, Oregon, good night."

If my report has proved to your satisfaction that I did hear KQIK, I would like to receive a QSL card or letter of verification. It is important to me that your reply contain the time and date of the confirmed broadcast and is signed by a station official. For this purpose I have enclosed return postage. I would also be interested in obtaining a coverage map, if possible. Thank you.
