I am pleased to report reception of your station on 12 February 1967

from 5:16pm M to 5:30pm M Eastern Standard Time on 1110 kcs.

Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

- 5:16: Two stations, one rock 'n' roll -- other classical music, either CFML or WBT.
- 5:17: "Bulletin" Latin American Treaty signed in Mexico City establishes a Nuclear Free Zone in Latin America. Rock Music continues.
- 5:18: WNAR fades behind other station - talk - "...21 point lead....San Francisco Warriors...." Sports News. Ad or PSA for a job opportunity - more information call 649-15?? or ?65-3232.
- 5:19¹/₂: Music for jingle: "With the emphasis on music, the emphasis on entertainment, and the emphasis on you, it's WNAR, emphatically!" Recorded ad for the Joe Pyne Show - 10:05 am Monday through Friday on Fun Radio, WNAR-1110 Norristown. Mondays guest - man claiming to be the Grand National Wizard of the Ku Klux Klan. At 11:05 it's rock and roll.
- 5:20: WNAR fades.
- 5:22: WNAR fades in with Sax instrumental.
- 5:22¹/₂: WNAR music unreadable - WBT loud and clear.
- 5:30: WBT weakens a bit. Heard "....until tomorrow, this is W.N.A.R." Assume sign-off ann't. 10 seconds later heard ".....Central Standard Time 4:30....." KFAB ?

I live in Wakefield, which is a suburb about ten miles north of Boston.
