Please accept this as confirmation of your report of reception of our transmission on November 30, 1964, from 4:53 to 5:00 a.m. AST, and on December 21, 1964, from 4:59 to 5:02:30 a.m. AST.

The reason no call of CFCY is given is that from 12:00 Midnight until 6:00 a.m. AST we carry programs supplied by the CBC. We run this period completely unmanned so that no live or taped calls can be given. However, your report is correct in that we are the only Canadian station east of Montreal on 630 KCS.


Our transmitter power at the moment is 5,000 Watts but this spring we will be changing to 10,000.

You now can include a verification from P.E.I. in your collection and I very much doubt if you will receive any other stations on the Island, because the only other one is a very low power (250 Watts, I believe) station located in Summerside.
