We are happy to verify your report of reception of Radio KIT in Yakima, Washington.

The City of Yakima is located in Yakima County. KIT is the pioneer station in the area, having been on the air since 1929.

KIT operates on a power of 5,000 watts during the day and 1,000 at night on our AM, and 25,000 watts both horizontally and vertically on FM. We are on the air 24 hours a day with both AM and FM. Our frequency is 1280 on the dial for the AM and 94.5 on the FM.
