Thank you for your reception report of WTTN *FM*, dated *3/16/70*

Please accept this letter as confirmation of your report.

WTTN operates on a frequency of 1580 kilocycles, with 1000 watts, non-directional, on a sunrise to sunset schedule. Our transmitter is located one-quarter mile west of the Watertown city limits just off Highway 19. Our studios and offices are in the Wisconsin National Bank Building at 104 West Main Street, Watertown. The transmitting equipment is remote controlled from the studios.

Watertown Radio Incorporated, our parent company, also operates WTTN-FM. WTTN-FM operates on a frequency of 104.7 megacycles, channel 284, with 10,000 watts effective radiated power on a day/night schedule. The programs duplicate WTTN. Our FM transmitter is at the same location as the AM with the antenna side mounted on the 150 foot AM tower. Control is from the studios.

Thank you again for your fine report. Your report is used by the engineering department to estimate signal coverage and to study radio signal propagation.
