Dear Mr. Leland:

Answering your communication of December 2, we have recording equipment at Station WSUI which was made in our own laboratories. It comprises a heavy turntable driven by a synchronous motor. This motor also drives a lathe attachment which carries a cutting tool across the record as it revolves. Our recording head is made from a Western Electric 2-C reproducer which has been mechanically and electrically damped and which drives a diamond point needle. Most of our recordings are made on blank metal discs and a special amplifier is used which corrects for deficiencies.

I hope this answers your question but will be glad to supply more information in case you desire it. This will also thank you for a report on the signals of Station WSUI.
