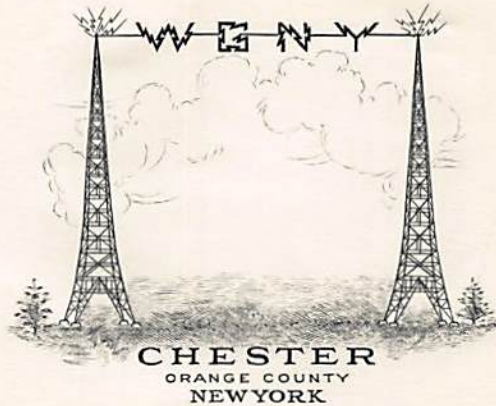

Thank you very much for your communication of the 4th, and this reply will constitute a full verification of your reception at the times named in your letter.


I see that you are a "ham", and so you might be interested to know that B. J. Fuld, my radio attorney, is director of the Hudson Division, A.R.R.L.
