Dear Rolland:

Thanks for the report on our air signal...our chief engineers are going crazy that the signal is that strong. I am news director... and I got the note... and the job of answering.

We had one hell of a time with hurricane Eloise... and I was at the station for about 36 hours... most of the time running between the microphone and the teletype, getting more info on the storm. I got about 4 hours sleep. The next day I hopped a Coast Guard Chopper and flew into the storm area, Fort Walton Beach and Panama City, Florida, about 3 hours after the storm had passed.

It was quite a sight.

I'm sure that you got readings on other stations along the Gulf coast that stayed on the air... there were quite a few, and most of the area was up all night, trying to find out where the storm was going to hit.

Once again, thanks for the logging. A coverage map is enclosed, as per your request. Have a good one.
