
Dear Sir:

From the details enclosed, I believe that you were tuned to our test transmissions on Monday morning. I believe there must be a great many stations off the air overnight Sunday-Monday because since we recently started playing music during our testing and maintenance, the number of QSL's has increased tremendously. Perhaps it is also a good year for DXing.

CJOY AM consists of an RCA BTA-10K 10,000/5,000 watt transmitter feeding three towers for a directional pattern (DA-2). We use quarter wave towers (164') perhaps accounting for some of our skywave signal.
