WGBS operates on 710 Khz (422.5 meters) with 50,000 watts full time, using two directional patterns. The daytime pattern is nearly circular and the nighttime pattern is directional primarily to the south. Our main transmitter is an RCA BTA - 50 H feeding three towers daytime and six towers nighttime.

WGBS programs "middle of the road" music and news to the largest coverage area of any South Florida station and is, we are happy to say, among the most popular stations in Florida.

WGBS is owned and operated by Storer Broadcasting Company.
